Last month there was a dinner (restaurant closed) and an activity that had to be cancelled due to insurance issues. The issue was the late notice to Insurance. The lodge has its insurance coverage through the San Francisco Hall Association and once a year our Secretary does a list of events. When new events come up, we have to contact the insurance company to make sure that the event would be covered. Thus, we need at least two months from planning the event to doing the actual event. Per the SFHA, "Keep in mind that if a private vehicle is used to go to and from an event is not insured by us; vehicle owners have their own auto insurance. The same goes for vehicle rentals. Also if an event is at a member's home, that is not insured, as the home owner has Home Owners coverage. Setting these guidelines years ago has reduced the cost of our insurance, enabling to insure many other events. There are times the broker and company will reject some activities (sky diving, white water rafting, etc.)" Food for thought - some lodges that do not meet at the Odd Fellows Hall carry their own insurance so that they can do extra events.
